This tank-mixture may also cause some visual crop response under some environmental conditions that is usually temporary with no subsequent effect on yield.	
POST 2 6-8 leaf cotton	(Roundup PowerMAX® II Herbicide (32 fl oz/acre) + XtendiMax® Herbicide with VaporGrip® Technology (22 fl oz/acre) + Labelled DRA or Liberty® + Dual® Magnum.	
LAY-BY OR HOODED SPRAYER	Roundup PowerMAX [®] II Herbicide (22-32 fl oz/acre) or MSMA (2 pt/acre) + Diuron + 0.5%
