### Program Details

- Consult your dealer for product availability and program requirements. Talk to your local Bayer representative for the best weed management recommendation. If a farmer experiences less than commercially acceptable performance on labeled weeds<sup>6</sup> within 30 days after the post-emergence application while following all program requirements, Bayer will pay up to \$15/acre (up to \$10/acre for broadleaf weeds and up to \$5/acre for grasses) or up to \$12/A for broadleaf weeds and grasses when a glufosinate herbicide is substituted for a labeled PPO-inhibiting herbicide to assist in a second post-emergence application on the affected acres (only if respray occurs to manage an additional flush of weeds). All claims subject to verification and approval of claims by Bayer at its sole discretion.
